- 🪗 Campers bringing small tents will be allowed to set up in the Sandia Room only; campers without tents will be allowed to set up in various exhibit spaces around the Museum to be directed by Camp-In staff.
- 🪗 Event will conclude and campers must depart by 7 a.m. on August 1.
- 🪗 A minimum of 60 participants must be met for event to occur. Fewer than 60 registrations may result in event cancellation. Campers will be notified by **email only** in the event the Camp-In is cancelled.
